Many of those living at Care Corner are originally from rural or tribal areas. But like many places around the globe, today's Thailand is experiencing rapid urbanization and industrialization. Thailand is fast becoming a member of the 'global village" of today's world.

Care Corner is situated just 30 minutes drive from the second largest and number one fastest growing urban area in Thailand: Chiang Mai... whose population is now well over ONE MILLION PEOPLE and growing daily. And the modern urban Thailand is rapidly surrounding the once remote Care Corner Orphanage location.

We seek to equip these precious children for a life of impact in the rapidly urbanizing Thai culture. We are trusting God to intentionally raise these children in such a way that they will have the skills and spiritual strength to transform a nation for God's glory as they live wise and godly lives in the new "urban jungle."

As future members of the Thai workforce, we must prepare these children to thrive in an increasingly complex and technologically modern culture. This means more of many things, including more rigorous education.

Raising young disciples in a rapidly urbanizing setting and preparing them for adulthood in this new environment incurs more expense than similar homes in a previous generation that were located in remote rural and tribal settings.

So, in the midst of that pursuit, we currently need more sponsors to help support the children and young people who live here.
