Pong's Story: I'm done running!

When my mum deserted the family, my dad left me in a children's home with one thousand other children. I was 6 years old.

That was my first encounter of running. Though I was only 6 years old and had polio, I ran away from that over-crowed place almost immediately.

Within a few months, I was picked up by the welfare department and sent to a home for disabled children. After two months of staying in that place, I ran for the second time. This time it lasted for fourteen years.

I spent fourteen years of miserable, meaningless life on the streets. It was a daily fight for survival.

I did not understand why or what I was running away from. All I wanted was to find an answer for my meaningless life..... I longed for a real home and a real meaning in life.

When I heard that Chiangmai has the best Water Festival (Thailand's New Year) celebration in Thailand, I made my way there to join the revelers. While in Chiangmai, a German man approached me and told me about Jesus.

Long years on the street had made me able to quickly recognize good things and bad things. The chance to know my true Father and my true heavenly home? I knew this was a good "opportunity." I immediately knew that this was the life's meaning that I had been looking for. This was the "home" my heart had longed for the past 14 years. Without any hesitation, I believed.

Now I'm done with my running – because God found me!
